- 3. The option was granted on September 17, 2019 for 43,198 shares. 25% of the shares underlying the option vested on October 1, 2020, and the remainder are scheduled to vest in equal monthly installments thereafter until October 1, 2023.
- 4. The option was granted on September 17, 2019 for 161,995 shares. The shares underlying the option vest in equal monthly installments until October 1, 2023.
- 5. The option was granted on June 25, 2019 for 21,599 shares. The shares underlying the option vested on April 1, 2020.
